

#### **ASB cards**

You will need your ASB card a lot this year so make sure to hold on to it! The ASB card can give you free admission to games, and discounted admission to the school dances (Homecoming/ Prom), and will help you check out books at the library.

Your ASB card will provide you with a 6-digit number which will be how you purchase various things around school. You can type in your number to purchase snacks at the café, food in the lunch line, and goods at the student store. You will end up memorizing your student number quicker than you think.

#### **School supplies**

<u>General:</u> Most teachers will tell you if you need something specific for your class, but everything else is up to you! Many students use binders and folders to keep track of their assignments. We do not have lockers on our campus! All materials are kept in your backpacks.

<u>Textbooks:</u> You will get textbooks at the beginning of the year from the library using your ASB card and student number. You will need to return semester course textbooks at the end of the semester, and year-long course textbooks at the end of the year. You can also borrow textbooks from the library if you need them for temporary use.

#### Qmaltiv(Skyward)

Skyward/Qmlativ is a website in which you find your grades, attendance record, and balance of your lunch account. Teachers will update your gradebook on Skyward, and your report card will also be sent out from the Skyward system.

Your parents can also refill your lunch account on Skyward. You can purchase snacks from the student store, lunch line, and café/snack line using your 6-digit student number and school account balance.

#### Attendances

MIHS uses the WHAMMO system which means a prearranged absence form. If you plan on missing a day or period or part of a period for an appointment or vacation make sure to fill out a WHAMMO.

Each student has 5 days to turn in an attendance note and a WHAMMO for the date of absence. After that each student can only hand in a late note to excuse the absence.

Make sure to excuse your absences because a large number of unexcused absences can cause students to not receive assigned parking spots junior and senior year on campus.

#### Parking

Our school has 3 parking lots on campus.

- Strip:
  - For the students who do not receive parking (Sophomores, juniors, and some seniors) they can park on our school's "strip". This is a street **(88th Ave SE)** by the high school where students can park on the gravel. The parking spans the whole street.
  - Directly across from C LOT
- C LOT:
  - Seniors designated Parking area is the "C-lot" or the "stadium lot". The seniors can purchase a year-long parking pass for this area costing 150\$, but this lot is still first come first serve with limited spaces.
  - Directly across from strip

- Visitors Lot:
  - Lot for any visitors to our school
  - parents, volunteers, teachers etc.
  - Don't park here you will be fined
- Northwood lower parking lot
  - The elementary school neighboring the high school
  - This parking area is lottery-based
  - permanent

School begins at 8 and depending on where you live, allow 20-30 minutes to find a parking spot on the strip and walk to the campus building.

# Spirit days and Spirit wear

Our school colors are maroon and white and every Friday is a maroon and white spirit day here at MIHS.

You can purchase spirit gear on fees and photo day. If you enroll at Mercer Island at a later date you can purchase spirit gear at the student store (open during both lunches) or various online websites that sell Mercer Island merchandise.

# Lunch line/Snack line/ Student store

Lunch line: Our lunch line serves 2 different specials every day, one of the school's personal favorites is the pasta served on Mondays.

The snack line/ the café: Here you can acquire snacks and various "coffee shop" inspired drinks like lattes and Italian sodas.

Student store: The student store has a slightly different selection of snacks and foods from the regular lunch line The student store also has various candies, gums, and spirit wear.

You can purchase goods at all of these stores using your 6-digit student number from your ASB card.

#### Schedule

Our school runs on a block schedule, which means that on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, you do not have all 7 periods. On Monday, Thursday, and Friday we attend all 7 periods of class. On Tuesdays, we have periods 1,3,5, and 7 for an hour and a half per period. On Wednesdays, we have periods 2,4, islander hour, and 6 (Islander Hour is a 50-minute period where we will do various surveys, class activities, and advisory/ free work periods).
